Large Scale Project on the Rosati Fast-Track Program

In 2000, the original goal for 625 Sprucewood was a large scale logistics and industrial park. The original master plan called for four large facilities for industrial use or logistic warehousing. The initial intent of the properties are coming to fruition with a few revisions to suit tenant goals.

Rosati is currently developing an expansion of the first building for a new tenant. When completed, the expansion will add a

total 205,855 square feet, bringing the overall facility to over 300,000 Square feet.

The expansion is being conventionally-constructed, and will include a new two-storey office area. The new space will also incorporate eight loading docks, and machine foundations to accommodate specialty equipment, and will be outfitted with 25 and 10 ton crane systems.
