South Korean company **Dongshin Motech Ltd.**, which operates in Canada as **DS C&K Inc.**, approached **Rosati** to design-build its first facility in Canada. With a global presence, **DS C&K** will be a direct supplier to the new battery plant currently being constructed in Windsor.

**Rosati** was chosen for its single-source design-build capabilities, and has completed all the processes of this development on Wheelton Dr., allowing the client to focus on its new Canadian business plan and outfitting the facility with its equipment.

The new manufacturing site has three planned phases, with Phase 1 currently under construction. It is comprised of a 15,000-square-foot, two-storey office and 91,670 square feet

of a manufacturing area and support spaces. It also includes a specialized 18,000-square-foot electro-static manufacturing area. When all three phase are completed, the facility will include capacity for 10-ton cranes and measure over 271,000 square feet.
